THE BACK BOOT PROJECT

The Back Boot Project was first conceived of as 'Little Politic', an exhibition which referred to material specific, small objects – an emphasis on the intimacy of the small object, the double take, the second glance and the unexpected. The Back Boot Project is a moving exhibition space in the back of a 1986 Toyota Corolla.

The boot of the Toyota Corolla operates as a vehicle for artists to locate their work outside the usual gallery sphere, into public spaces. The Back Boot Project is primarily about space. Like the gallery it has its own set of limitations and challenges. Each artist contributes their own individual projects to the BBP and may (because they are shown in the back boot of the car) implicitly refer to other ideas surrounding mobility, non-space or transitional spaces.

The Poster show is the final Back Boot Show for 2007 and includes A1 posters of each Back Book Project, remnants of exhibitions and objects that are exhibited from Boot to Gallery in pseudo-documentary fashion.
